PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM (4Ps) RECIPIENTS

A. DESCRIPTION

The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps), under REPUBLIC ACT No. 11310, is a Philippine government's measure for human development that provides conditional cash grants to the poorest of the poor, to improve the health, nutrition, and the education of children aged 0-18. One of its objectives is social development through breaking the intergenerational poverty cycle by investing in the health and education of poor children.

Marinig South Elementary School supports the 4Ps by providing the suitable educational and health assistance to help the children develop a better future. Ensuring that they grow into educated and healthy adults, is the equivalent of teaching them how to fish.









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
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B. DATA/RESULT (PRE AND CURRENT DATA)

From April 2022 to April 2023, there is a decrease in 4Ps recipients from 60 to 30 beneficiaries.









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C. INTERVENTION

In the implementation of the 4Ps, there is a noticeable increase in the number of enrollees in many elementary schools including in MSES. The school also supports the healthy development of the individual, lessen the incidence of child labor and avoid other forms of child abuse. In line with this, the school imposed a strict monitoring system to ensure the attendance of the student beneficiaries at least 85% of school days per month.

On the other hand, the 4Ps adult beneficiaries were encouraged to be part of the "Gulayan sa Paaralan" volunteers to grow their own vegetables and fruits that will further sustain their food to be healthy.
