

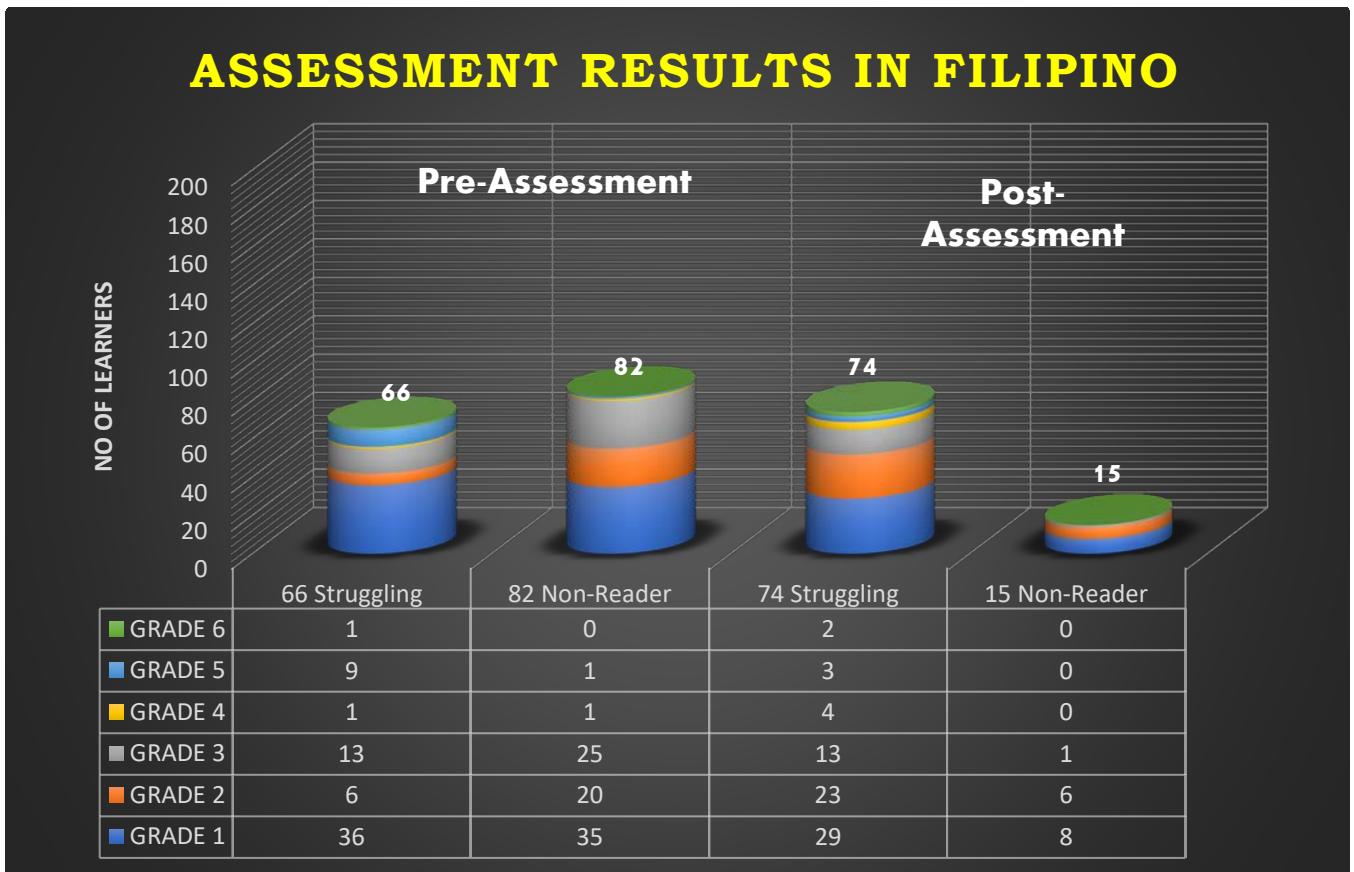

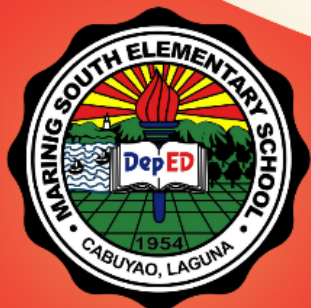
**ASSESSMENT RESULT OF STRUGLING AND NON-READER**

SY:2022-2023



The figure above shows the reading assessment in Filipino during the Pre-assessment and Post-Assessment. During the Pre-assessment, there were 66 identified struggling readers from Grade 1 to 6 and 82 recorded non-readers from Grade 1 to 5. Based on the data, Grade 1 had the highest number of struggling and non-readers.

On the Post-Assessment, the total number of struggling readers increased to 74, while the number of non-readers decreased to 15. Interestingly, the highest numbers of struggling and non-readers still belong to Grade 1.



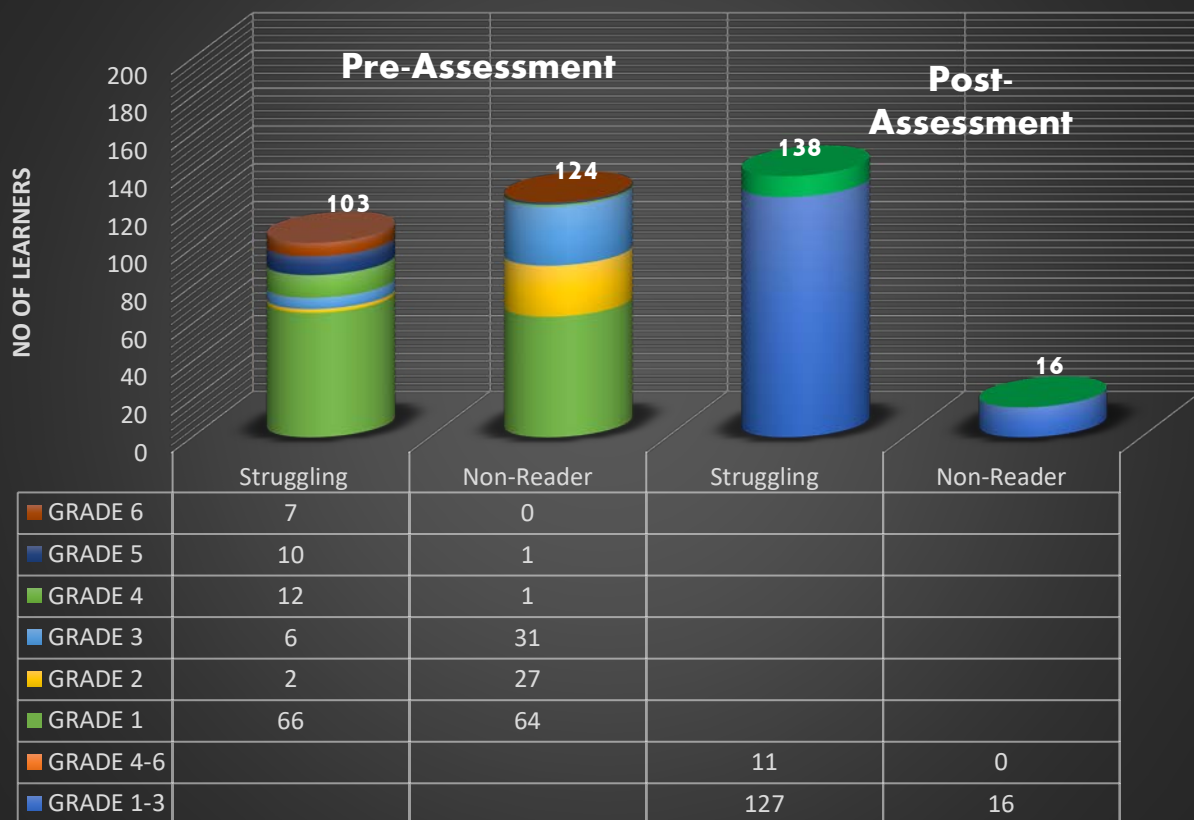

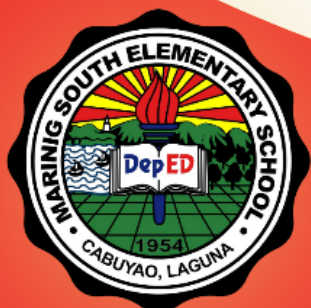

## ASSESSMENT RESULTS IN ENGLISH



The figure shows the results of the reading assessment in English during the Pre-assessment and Post-Assessment. Based on the data, there were 103 identified struggling readers and 124 non-readers. Grade 1 had the highest number of struggling readers with 66 and non-readers with 64 learners.

During the conduct of the post reading assessment, a total of 138 struggling readers and 16 non-readers were recorded.

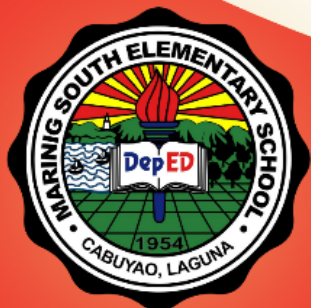
