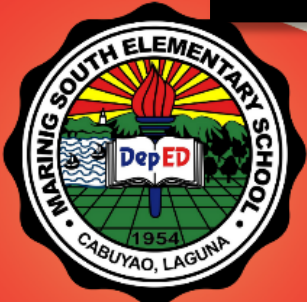
Likewise, activity reportorial documents are expected to be submitted to the Public Schools District Supervisor for information and evaluation reference.

**Enabling Objectives**

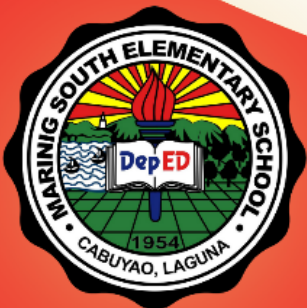
Specifically, this project aims to:

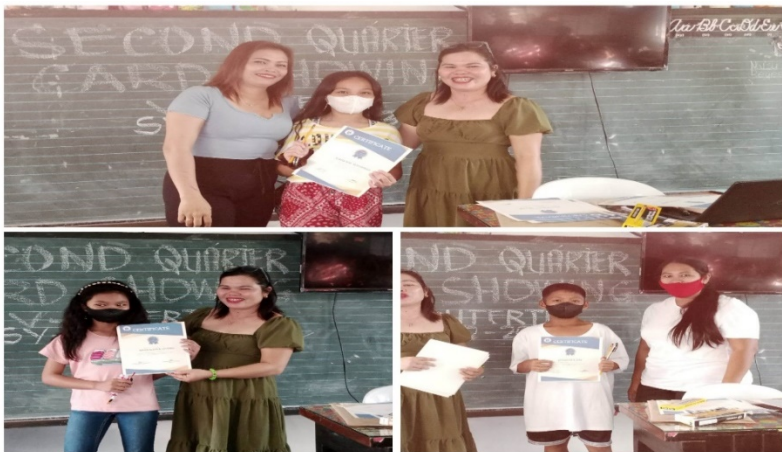

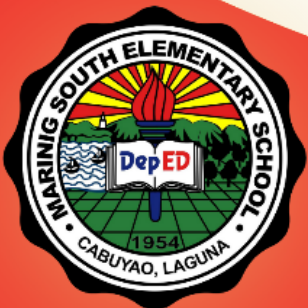
