MSES SCHOOL LIBRARY ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

Pursuant to Proclamation No. 837 s. 1991, the Library and Information Services (LIS) month which is commemorated during the month of November every year. In recognition of the need to focus public awareness to the invaluable service that libraries and information centers render. The CID-LRMDS section of the Division of Cabuyao will lead the division celebration while all the schools through their teacher – in- charge of the libraries are enjoined to conduct the school- based Library and Information Services (LIS) Celebration.

In connection with this, Marinig South Elementary school conducted a four-day activity for kinder to grade six pupils as a part of the 28th Library and Information Services (LIS) month celebration. The objective of the said activity is to enhance literacy skills and develop love for reading. The activities help to promote library to reach out the interest of the pupils. These motivates them to regularly visit their school library based on their scheduled time. Allowing such activities give chance to the pupils to develop their knowledge and their manipulative skills.

When Cabuyao established a City Schools Division, LRMDS were also created. At that time Dr. Jonathan F. Bernabe served as OIC- EPS on the said section. During that time many schools have no libraries. As a result, he conducted trainings and workshops on how to establish effective library for our learners. Conducting storytelling and card cataloging are some of the topics tackled during the seminars. We also visited a well-established library such as De La Salle University's Library. In our school, Marinig South Elementary School we found out that books are just neglected. Some were damage because it got wet during rainy season. We tried to retrieve usable books. It was not easy in our part since it is almost an abandoned room. It was so dusty; the cabinets were also destroyed. With the help of Mrs. Perez bookshelves are fixed. We segregate usable from unusable books. We did that for a









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couple of weeks. During holidays, we stayed in the library for inventory and applied what we learned from the trainings.

Furthermore, a Division Library Contest were conducted. That time the untidy room that became tidy was used by the kindergarten. So, we thought of transferring the books since library should not be used as classroom. We asked permission from Ms. Menchie Delfinado our former principal to convert the stockroom into a library. For a one-week preparation we did a great job. As they visited in schools there were 28 libraries established in our division. Luckily, we got $3^{\rm rd}$ place in that contest.

For the school year 2018-2019, We had our new Education Program Supervisor Dr. Jackie Lou A. Almira. We held a meeting and election of officers. Mrs. Rosefe B. Bernabe was elected as Division LRMDS President. A series of activities were made this year including updated learning inventories, story book writing Contest, Readers Theater, Quiz Bee, seminars, and workshop. We had three entries in story book writing contest. Among the given entries, we had two winners, Ma. Eda C. Lapidez- First Place and Ma. Laila Jane L. Malabanan -Third Place. We also participated in the Division LIS month Celebration for quiz bee grade five pupils with their coach Ma. Eda C. Lapidez and readers' theater for grade six pupils with their coach Leila F. Javier. In this school year, we also updated inventory of our learning resources specifically the k-12 learner's materials in August 2018, February, and March 2019. However, a trouble comes in our way, the library building was demolished. But we transfer it successfully under the stairs. It is quite small, but we tried our best for it to be attractive to our learners.
