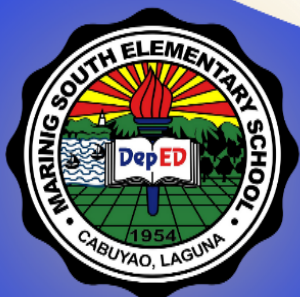
**SCOUTERS ROCK: Keep schools and offices safe and eco-friendly**

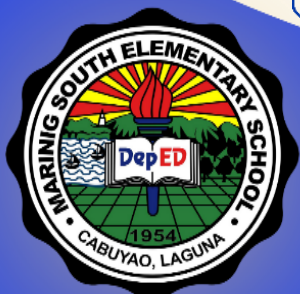

**MSES conducts disinfection of school buildings and facilities in partnership with LGU Bgy. Marinig**

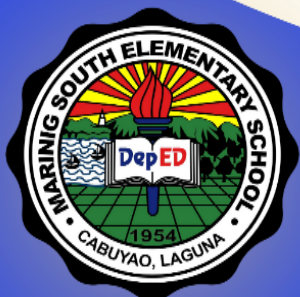
Due to ongoing public health situation brought by COVID-19 pandemic, Vice President and Education Secretary Sara Z. Duterte reiterated that health, safety and well-being of school learners, officials, teachers and non-teaching personnel remain utmost considerations for school opening. Furthermore, Marinig South Elementary School held their virtual meeting of Brigada Eskwela Kick-off last August 1, 2022 which were attended by the teaching and non-teaching personnel in preparation for the school year 2022-2023.

The lenient School learning leader Mr. Emmanuel B. Cerda stressed that “learning shouldn’t stop and education for every learner is important especially during this crisis and we need to be ready for the start of the classes which will be on August 22, 2023.”

In the meeting, one of the highlights of the school kick-off activities were regular school disinfection and decontamination of school buildings and facilities for healthy and safe workplace as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 14 s. 2020 otherwise known as Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools.

In response to this, the school parent-teacher association headed by Pres. Nelson Delfinado, SDRRM coordinator Juan Mario P. Yumena and School Covid19 Task Force Vilma A. Reyes initiated the disinfection of the school premises in partnership with Local Government of Barangay Marinig chaired by Emiliano T. Lirio - Barangay Chairman and the rest Sangguniang Barangay whose advocacy is to stop the occurrence of COVID-19 cases and infection among the teaching and non-teaching personnel in preparation for the opening of classes.

Hence, the teachers were then also instructed to prepare all the necessary

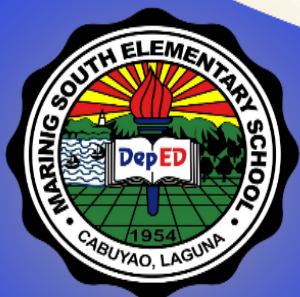

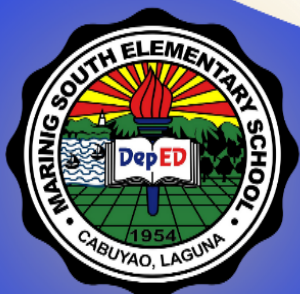
